Presidential Election 2009

The current term of office for UPSE President will expire this year immediately following the annual convention. Nomination forms and information for candidates is available at the UPSE office. The deadline for nominations is Monday, July 20, 2009 at 4:00 p.m.

An election will be conducted by a mail-out - mail-in ballot format between August 13, 2009 and September 10, 2009. The results will be verified and announced on September 11, 2009. The term of office will run for three years and will begin immediately following the annual convention.

All members in good standing, as per the July 25, 2009 payroll lists, will have a ballot mailed to their home address. If you have not been receiving information from the Union during the past year, or if you have recently moved or had a name change, please call Tammy at the UPSE office 892-5335 or toll-free at 1-800-897-8773 to update your information.

Odd numbered locals to elect Directors

The term of office for Directors of odd-numbered locals expires following this year's annual convention. A call for nominations has been issued by the Membership Services Committee and will remain open until August 1, 2009 at 4:00 p.m. Elections, if necessary, will be conducted via a mail-in ballot during the month of August.

To be eligible for nomination you must:

- Be a member in good standing of the applicable local for at least the past 12 months
- Be nominated by a member in good standing from the applicable local
- Have taken the "Welcome to UPSE": or its equivalent course

Nomination forms are available at the UPSE office. Completed forms MUST be accompanied by a short biography of the nominee.

Employees at P.E.I. Grain Elevators Inc. ratify new two-year agreement

Bargaining representatives, Wade Waddell and Debbie Montgomery assisted by UPSE Labour Relations Officer, Hans Connor were successful in reaching a tentative agreement. The agreement was ratified by 100 percent of voting members. Highlights of the two-year deal include:

- * The addition of a shift premium for all hours worked on night shifts
 - * Increased compensation for long-term casuals
- * A wage increase of 2 percent PLUS cash bonuses of \$1000 in each of the two years
- * An extension to the length of harvest season which will expand access to overtime availability
