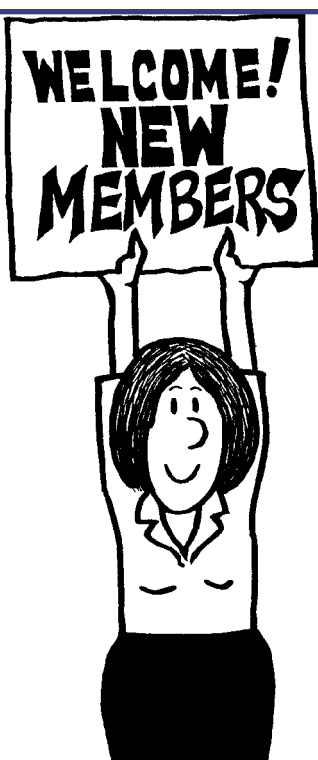
*On May 6, 2011 members ratified their first collective agreement with 93% in favour. The bargaining team consisted of Trudy Stewart and Louise Maye (Whisperwood Villa), and Troy Warren (PEI UPSE). Wage parity was among the most significant issues.*

*On April 4, 2011 Gillis Lodge joined PEI UPSE - the largest union on Prince Edward Island.*

*PEI UPSE is proud to represent approximately 70 members at Gillis Lodge consisting of LPNs and RCWs, as well as Kitchen, Housekeeping and Activities staff.*

*PEI UPSE is currently conducting education sessions on bargaining with members from Gillis Lodge, and will be distributing demand forms to members in the near future, in order to begin preliminary work on the first collective agreement.*
