To be eligible for nomination as a Director a member must:

- *be in good standing for at least the previous twelve months (1 yr.)*
- *be nominated by a member in good standing of the applicable local*
- *have completed the Welcome to PEI UPSE or equivalent course*

Deadlines and important information:

- **All nominations must be received at the union office by 4:00 p.m. on August 1, 2013**
- **If necessary, an election will be held by August 31, 2013**
- **Union policy outlines that a biography must be included with the nomination form**

PEI UPSE calls for nominations for top positions in union: 1st Vice-President and 3rd Vice-President

PEI UPSE's Executive Nominations Committee is calling for nominations for the election of the 1st Vice-President and 3rd Vice-President. An election for these positions will be held at the union's Annual Convention coming up in November, 2013. As executive positions, these are two-year terms of office.

Nominations for the positions of 1st Vice-President and 3rd Vice - President require the following:

- ***nominees must be members in good standing for at least one year***
- ***nominations must include signatures of the nominator and seconder (both must be members in good standing)***
- ***a biography of the nominee that accompanies the nomination form***



The deadline for submitting nomination forms is 4:00 p.m. on Monday, August 19, 2013. If nominations are not received by the deadline, they will also be invited from the convention floor at UPSE's Annual Convention.
