If you would like to participate on the bargaining team please attend your upcoming category meeting (see page 2 of this Accent for dates, times and locations).



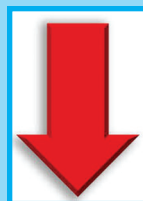
Step #2: Return your demand forms to the UPSE office by September 6/16.
