# Call for nominations: UPSE 2nd Vice-President and Secretary- Treasurer

PEI UPSE's Executive Nominations Committee is calling for nominations for the election of the 2nd Vice-President and Secretary-Treasurer. An election for these positions will be held at the union's Annual Convention in November 2016. As executive positions, these are two-year terms of office.

*Nominations for the positions of 2nd Vice-President and Secretary-Treasurer require the following:*

- *nominees must be members in good standing for at least one year*
- *nominations must include signatures of the nominator and seconder (both must be members in good standing)*
- *a biography of the nominee must accompany the nomination form*

*The deadline for submitting nomination forms is 4:00 p.m. on Monday, August 22, 2016. If nominations are not received by the deadline, they will also be invited from the convention floor at UPSE's Annual Convention.*
