## 2017 Police & Peace Officers Memorial Service

This is the 20th year that UPSE and the Community and Correctional Services Division will cosponsor attendance at the Police and Peace Officers Memorial Service in Ottawa. The memorial service honours police and peace officers who sacrificed their lives to keep our communities safe. The service also provides an opportunity for participants to engage in networking and professional development activities.

### *Application process*

Those wishing to attend must complete an application form available at the UPSE office, website ([www.peiupse.ca](http://www.peiupse.ca)), or respective workplace. Four participants will be selected from the front line of Youth Workers, Correctional Officers, Probation Officers, and the Sheriff department to attend the march.

Representatives will depart September 22, 2017, and will return on September 25, 2017. Applicants must be UPSE members in good standing. Completed applications are to be returned to the UPSE office no later than **July 28, 2017**.

The representatives attending requiring uniforms, are to contact Vicki McMillan, Stores Supervisor at PCC to ensure they have a uniform to wear for the service. As well, all out-of-province travel claims must be submitted a minimum of **20 days prior to departure** to the respective Manager so it can be forwarded for approval at the deputies level.

Accommodations are provided by UPSE. Van transportation will be provided by Community and Correctional Services and two (2) days paid leave (for scheduled shifts) will be provided by the employees' respective work sites. **The balance of time taken by employees for scheduled shifts will be covered by UPSE.**
