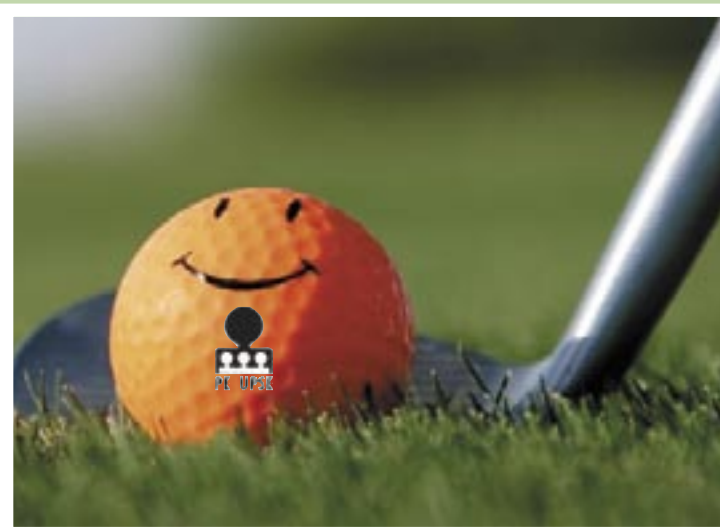
UPSE Annual Golf Tournament

"Taking a Break for Wellness"

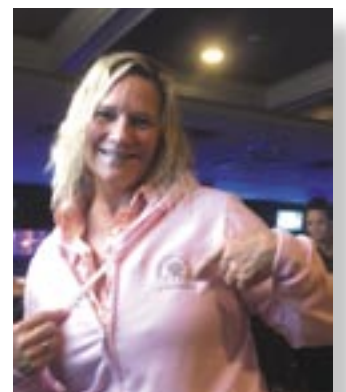
The UPSE Women's Committee arranged a wellness event to support women in taking- a- break from all the roles they carry every day!
