## UPSE Annual Golf Tournament

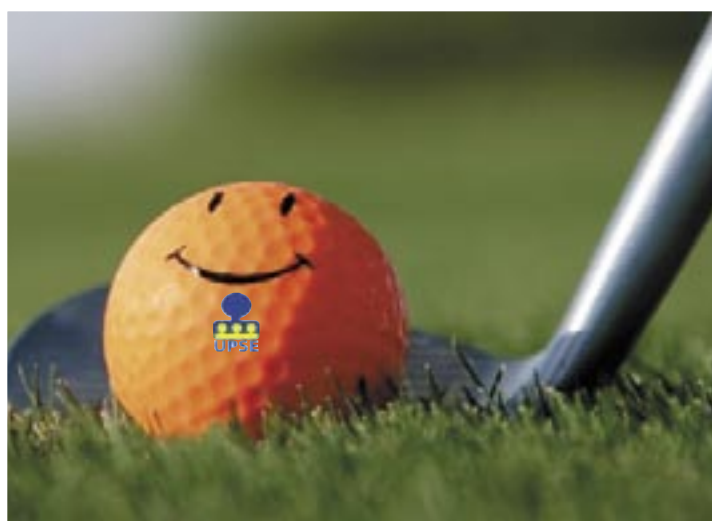

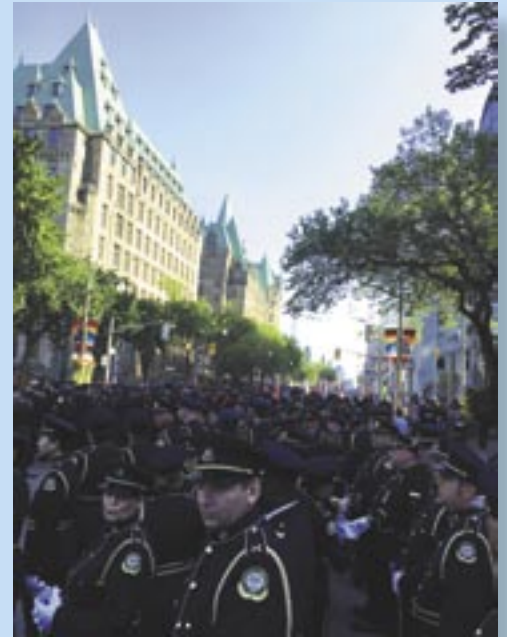

## 2019 Police & Peace Officers Memorial Service

This is the 22nd year that UPSE and the Community and Correctional Services Division will cosponsor attendance at the Police and Peace Officers Memorial Service in Ottawa. The memorial service honours police and peace officers who sacrificed their lives to keep our communities safe. The service also provides an opportunity for members to engage in networking and professional development activities.

### *Application process*

Those wishing to attend must complete an application form available at the UPSE office, website ([www.peiupse.ca](http://www.peiupse.ca)), or respective workplace. Four members will be selected from Youth Workers (who work with youth in custody), Correctional Officers, Probation Officers, and the Sheriff department to attend the march. Representatives will be departing September 27, 2019, and returning on September 30, 2019. Applicants must be UPSE members in good standing. Completed applications are to be returned to the UPSE office no later than **Friday, August 9, 2019**.



For those members requiring uniforms for the service, please contact Vicki MacMillan, Stores Supervisor at PCC. As well, all out-of-province travel claims are to be submitted a minimum of 20 days prior to departure to the respective Manager so it can be forwarded for approval at the deputies level.

Accommodations are provided by UPSE. Van transportation will be provided by Community and Correctional Services and two (2) days paid leave (for scheduled shifts) will be provided by the employees' respective work sites. **The balance of time taken by employees for scheduled shifts will be covered by UPSE.**
