



National Union (2024 Scholarships)

The online application portal for the National Union Scholarships is now open. The webpage outlines the unique entry requirements for each of the scholarships (https://nupge.ca/scholarships/).

All scholarships are open to students with a full or part-time course of study leading to a diploma or degree.

The deadline for applications is **Sunday**, **June 30**, **2024**, **at 5pm EDT** at which time the portal will close.



Entrants may apply to any or all scholarships that they are eligible for but only one award may be received. Due to the eligibility rules for the *Young Worker Scholarships*, applicants may re-apply provided they have not previously won this scholarship, they are still in school and are under the age of 31 as of the deadline.
